On Saturday, April 18, 2009, Mothers Against Drunk Driving (MADD) hosted their annual California Statewide Law Enforcement & Community Recognition Dinner in Sacramento. Deputy Justin Millmore received the Law Enforcement Award for distinguished service in the prevention of drunk driving.

Deputy Justin Millmore has been with the San Joaquin County Sheriff's Office for three and a half years. He was selected by and assigned to Lathrop Police Services Division in September 2007 because of his high level of enthusiasm, energy, work ethic, and commitment to excellence. He is a top performer and a hard charger. This past year, his determination resulted in the detection, apprehension and arrest of impaired drivers under the influence of drugs and alcohol. While performing his basic patrol duties, he managed to take (26) DUI drivers off the street or roughly 25 percent of all DUI arrests made for the Division.

Help Keep our Parks and Streets Safe and Clean



The City of Lathrop has many parks for the enjoyment of our citizens. With the wonderful spring weather near it's a great time to get out and walk your pets. While using our parks, please keep in mind that if you bring your dog, your dog must be on a leash.

The folks down at City Hall would like to remind you to please pick up after your pets as you enjoy the outdoors. Not only will this keep your neighborhood looking great, but will make for a much better experience for your neighbors to enjoy a nice walk also. The Lathrop Municipal Code requires that all residents pick up after their pets when they do their business on any public property (parks, streets, sidewalks, etc) or the private property of any person in the City limits. While using any of our parks, please be courteous of your fellow citizens and pick up after you animals. Remember to carry bags with you to pick up after your pet. Those plastic bags from your grocer are great for litter-removal; they easily fit in your pocket and are ready when you need it.

Dogs Running Loose Prohibited, Including in City Parks

Dogs are not permitted to run loose on any public street, road, alley, park, square, school or other public place (parks included), or upon private property other than the property of the owner. Please be considerate of your neighbors and those who wish to use the parks by keeping your dogs on a leash at all times. Any dog found running loose can be impounded and/or a citation can be issued to the owner.

The only place dogs are allowed off leash is in the City's new Dog Park. The Dog Park is located at River Park South, 17801 Inland Passage Way, Lathrop. The park is a grass, fenced-in dog park to allow dogs to run free and play without a leash. The Dog Park will be closing during the summer due to construction for levee improvements. A temporary dog park will be opened at Mossdale Landing Community Park (700 Towne Centre Drive, Lathrop) while the Dog Park is closed. Please make sure to clean up after your dog at any park!
