NEED TO GET RID OF LARGE ITEMS?

Republic Services offers Lathrop households 2 bulk item pickups per year at no additional charge

In order to serve you better, bulk trash collection will now be done by appointment only. Please call our office at 209.466.3604 during the months of February through November for an appointment.

Please carefully review these guidelines, as piles that do not comply will go uncollected.

Bulk piles should measure no more than 2.5 cubic yards (3' high, 7.5' long and 3' wide), about the size of 3 washing machines.







Place your discarded bulk items to the curb the evening before your scheduled pickup day.

Total Cleanup Volume = 2.5 cubic yards. Any pile over 2.5 cubic yards will not be collected

Acceptable Items include:

- Furniture
- Appliances
- TVs/monitors
- Up to 4 tires without rims
- ✓ Begged or boxed small items (weighing no more than 50lbs) Please separate appliances and electronics from other bulk items for collection by a separate truck.



Unacceptable items include:

- Loose, unbagged items.
- S Bags or boxes more than 50lbs
- S Engines and engine parts
- Nazardous waste
- N Liquids
- Dirt, rock, concrete, bricks
