Welcome to Republic Services®

This program will help residents do their part to meet the state goal to recycle 75% of all waste. **This program cannot work without your help.** Please review this information carefully as you can help us create a cleaner, more sustainable Lathrop.

Your Choice of Cart

You choose the cart size that best fits your waste needs year-round. You are billed according to the size of the dry-bulked waste cart that you select:

- 30-Gallon Cart (2 tall kitchen bags)
- 60-Gallon Cart (4.5 tall kitchen bags)
- 90-Gallon Cart (7 tall kitchen bags)

Discounts:
We offer a 25% discount to senior citizens over the age of 65. Please contact our office for information on how to apply.

Damaged or Stolen Carts

- Please report to Republic Services at 209.466.3604 or use the Republic Services mobile app.

Clean Sweep by Appointment

- 2 free bulk waste pickups annually
- Call to schedule your appointment from February through November.

Annual Leaf and Limb Pickup

- During the first 2 weeks of January, leaves and limbs that do not fit into your organics cart will be collected on the curb.
- Leaves must be bagged and cannot exceed more than 50 lbs.
- Bundle brush with string or twine. Do not use wire.
- Limbs must not exceed 4 feet in length and 4 inches in diameter.

Batteries

- Place household batteries in small plastic bags on top of your recycling cart.

Used Motor Oil/Filter Recycling

- Next to your recycling cart, place motor oil in a 1-gallon, clear plastic milk jug with a screw-on lid, taped shut. Place with drained oil filters in a sealed, clear plastic zipper bag, and place next to your recycling cart.


Your Services (cont.)

Holiday Schedule

We service all holidays except Christmas Day and New Year's Day.

Christmas Tree Pickup


- During the first two weeks of January
- If your tree is taller than 6 feet, it must be cut in half to be collected (no artificial trees).



Empty. Clean. Dry.

Please make sure your recyclables are empty, clean and dry before placing them in your recycling cart.

No plastic bags.

Recycling
Ensure items are empty, clean and dry

Plastics
Recycle plastic containers #1 through #7

Metal Cans
Recycle all food and beverage metal cans (cans, tin, tin metal and aluminum)

Cardboard & Paper
Recycle envelopes, office paper, newspaper, magazines, junk mail, catalogs, paperback books, phone books, brochures, greeting cards and file folders.

Glass
Recycle clear and colored glass

Organics

Yard Debris
Flowers, grass cuttings, leaves, weeds, small tree and brush trimmings, yard trimmings

Food Scraps
Fruit, vegetables, bones, coffee grounds, dairy products, egg shells, fish, meat, grain products and baked goods

Cart Setout

Place carts curbside by 5 a.m. on your collection day. Drivers leave and 6 a.m. to service the carts.

Weekly - All 3 carts are emptied on the same day, but not by the same truck. You may choose to set out your recycling or organics carts only when full, which might not be every week.

Reasons waste may not be collected:

- Cart too far from curb
- Cart facing the wrong direction
- Overfilled or overweight cart
- Insufficient space to service cart (air blocking cart)
- Unacceptable material in cart
- Incorrect cart size


Containment - Please be sure to place all waste organics and recycling inside the correct cart and close all lids flat. Items placed outside the cart cannot be removed without an extra service sticker, unless you contact our office prior to collection day. There may be a fee for this service.

Curbside - Carts must be placed with wheels against the curb by 5 a.m. on your regular collection day, with the lid opening facing toward the street. Place carts in a visible location at least 2 feet apart and 6 feet away from mailboxes, trees, basketball hoops, cars or other stationary objects.

No: Plastic bags, food waste, yard waste, light bulbs, batteries, ceramics or dishes, electronics, clothing, polystyrene foam, hazardous waste, garden hoses, construction waste, pizza boxes, pots or pans

No: Plastic bags, bamboo, dead animals, dirt, rock, sand, lawn soil, manure or pet waste, paint, tires, cleaners, wood (painted or stained), wood from construction projects, recyclable materials, burn material or ash, trash

No: Batteries, construction materials, dry rock, sand, lawn soil, manure or pet waste, hazardous waste, hot ashes, medicines, needles and medical sharps, tires, used motor oil, filters
