

WATER UTILITY SERVICE SHUT-OFFS

Since the beginning of the COVID-19 pandemic, the City has suspended water utility service disconnections for non-payment and waived definquency fees an all utility accounts under the Governor's Executive Order N-42-20. This Executive Order has since been rescinded and it is time for the City's utility services to resume normal business operations, including service disconnections for non-payment and the assessment of late fees on all past due sume effective September 2022. If your account is more than 60 days past due, you will receive notification of the amount due and service disconnection date prior to service interruption.

The City of Lathrop is committed to helping our customers. If you are unable to pay your bill in full, please email <u>billing@cc.lathrop.ca.us or contact</u> us during normal business hours at (209) 941-7320 to discuss payment arrangements. We encourage you to make every attempt to continue to pay your water bill timely.

Customers may be eligible for other state and local assistance programs, such as the Low-Income Household Water Assistance Program (LIPWAP) — a new program that uses tederal funds to help eligible income cualified households by providing up to a \$2,000 one-time benefit per household and is not limited to the COVID-19 time period. 


