

APPOINTMENT OF VOTING DELEGATE & ALTERNATE FOR THE 2024 LEAGUE OF CALIFORNIA CITIES ANNUAL CONFERENCE

Background



- Policy development is a key part of the League of California Cities (League) effectiveness.
- The League holds an Annual Conference and Business Meeting to decide League policy for the upcoming year.
- ▶ The Annual Conference will be held at the Long Beach Convention Center in Long Beach, California, October 16–18, 2024.

Background (cont.)



- The League's Annual Conference Resolutions is one way that city officials can directly participate in the development of League policy.
- Council action is required to designate a voting delegate (and up to two alternates) in order to participate in the Business Meeting.
- Each member City has the right to cast one vote on matter pertaining to League policy.

Background (cont.)



- Conference registration required.
- The approximate cost per person is estimated at \$3,530 per person:
 - League Registration \$650 (register by October 4th)
 - Hotel/Transportation/Other \$2,880

Resolutions to be Voted on

- Resolutions must be submitted to Cal Cities no later than 60 days prior to the opening session of the conference. The deadline to submit Resolutions is August 17,2024.
- However, a petitioned Resolution can still be submitted during the Annual Conference and would need to be considered and voted on during the business meeting.
- The General Resolutions Committee will meet Thursday, October 17th to consider the matters on the agenda and any petitioned resolutions made during the conference.
- Final vote of General Assembly 8:30 a.m., October 18th
- The Resolutions process and the approval by the General Assembly during the Annual Conference become the official League of California Cities policy.

Appointment Discussion
