Specifications

Artwork must not exceed a size of four (4) feet in any direction. All artwork intended for hanging must be framed and ready to hang with wire. Unframed artwork on canvas must be finished, with fully painted edges. Artwork submitted should be original work of the artist, appropriate for public display, suitable for community viewing. Work previously in the Joyce Gatto Art Show and Sale is not eligible. Pieces <u>must</u> be accompanied by a **3"** by **5"** index card listing the Artist's name, address, telephone number, category, title of piece, and price of work.

Entry Fee | \$10 per entry

Artists may submit up to three (3) entries. The City reserves the right to choose artwork eligible for the contest and the entry fee will be returned if the piece is not displayed.

Art Sales

A 10% commission will be paid to the City of Lathrop for any pieces sold. Commission will be deducted from the artist's asking price.
