8. PUBLIC HEARING ITEMS

8.1 TownePlace Suites by Marriott Conditional Use Permit No. CUP-22-40 and Site Plan Review No. SPR-22-41.

Mr. Caguiat made the staff report presentation.

Commissioner Ralmilay asked if there is enough sewer capacity for the proposed hotel and Fairfield Inn. Mr. Caguiat replied that the applicant is required to obtain and purchase sewer capacity as one of the Condition of Approval prior to permit issuance.

Chair Dresser asked staff to explain the timing and the process of completing the Habitat and Air District Forms. Mr. Caguiat proceeded to explain the habitat and air district permitting process. He added that the applicant would have to provide proof that the project has complied with the corresponding agency guidelines prior to issuing a permit.

Chair Dresser inquired about electric vehicle charging stations (EVCS) & solar. Mr. Caguiat replied that the project is required to provide various improvements to comply with current Green Building Code. He pointed out that, the applicant may be eligible to receive fee credits by providing renewable energy and eco-friendly goods and services, as an incentive. Chair Dresser also asked if the project is required to provide different levels of electric chargers. Mr. Caguiat deferred the question to the applicant.

OPENED PUBLIC HEARING

Byron Chapman, applicant representative, came forward and explained that solar installation is not currently required but can be very advantageous for a hotel project. Although not currently part of the submitted plans, solar power would be considered after the CUP's approval.

Mr. Chapman also talked about providing various levels of EVCS that would cater to different vehicle charging capabilities.
