#### 8. PUBLIC HEARING ITEMS

8.1 Municipal Code Text Amendment TA-18-56.

Consider a resolution recommending City Council adopt amendments to the Lathrop Municipal Code (LMC) Title 17, the Zoning Code, Chapter 17.84 (Signs) with the specific purpose of establishing "content neutrality" for temporary noncommercial signage in all zoning districts, and associated amendments to various sections of the signage chapter to establish internal consistency.
