## ADDENDUM NO. 2 – November 14, 2024

## Request for Proposals For Mossdale Landing Community Park & Valverde Splash Pad and Baseball Fields Renovation CIP PK 24-04

This addendum amends the Request for Proposals (RFP) for this project as follows:

Proposed schedule for design shall be modified as reflected below per direction of the City, as they are anticipating construction by Summer of 2025 vs Spring of 2026.

**RFI 1:** Are there separate anticipated budgets for soft and hard costs, for Valverde Park improvements?

**A1:** No, at this time there is only one budget for both parks.

**RFI 2:** Is there an anticipated budget for Mossdale Landing Park improvements? **A2:** No

**RFI 3:** Is there a prior geotechnical report available? If not, will geotechnical services be provided by the City?

**A3:** No prior geotechnical report available, therefore the City will not be providing geotechnical reports. Consultant to add a separate line-item cost for Geotechnical as a Deliverable.

## 5. Deliverables

J. Geotechnical Services

**RFI 4:** Can the City provide any other available documentation (CAD bases, topographic survey)?

**A4:** No further documentation available. Surveying is a deliverable required of the Consultant and should be a separate line item for cost.

**RFI 5:** Has the City previously completed a needs assessment or public outreach for the two parks to confirm programming? If not, is that expected to be included in the scope of services?

**A5:** The City has gotten directions from City Council on how to proceed with parks programming. No further action is required of the consultant.

**RFI 6:** What is the limit of work boundary for both parks?

**A6:** The limits of work boundaries are set by work listed and scoped in proposal.

**RFI 7:** Are any other amenities desired besides what is listed in the RFP?

**A7:** No

**RFI 8:** Are the splash pads currently using a flow through system?

**A8:** Both systems are on potable water going into drainage system.

**RFI 9:** Does the City want construction to start in Spring/Summer 2026?

**A9:** Ideally, the City would like to break ground in late Spring 2025 for construction. The new proposed schedule is listed above.

**RFI 10:** Does the City want the splash pad equipment to be reused or replaced?

**A10:** Replaced, completely new design

**RFI 11:** Is there any other irrigation renovation requested outside of the potential baseball irrigation?

**A11:** No.

**RFI 12:** On Page 3, the RFP states: "Exemplary proposals will provide a proposal to the team showcasing their understanding and vision of the RFP." Can the meaning of this please be clarified?

**A12:** Consultant is to showcase their work and what we can expect from them based on an exemplary proposal.

**RFI 13:** Regarding Valverde Park, would the City be open to renovating the existing splash pad to provide hardscape improvements, instead of moving the splash pad entirely?

**A13:** Ideally, the City would like to move the splash pad away from the parking lot, but suggestions are welcome.

**RFI 14:** Regarding response to RFI 8 on Addendum #1: Can you please provide the construction budget for the project? Is this total or per park?

<b>A14:</b> Currently it is the total for both parks, however	er if EE say's o	different, we	e'll need to
either adjust budget or continue with Add. Alternatives on	plans.		

**RFI 15:** Can the City describe the scale/age-appropriate level for the zipline? Or is this to be determined by the designer?

**A15:** No, the zipline shall be in the scope of design.
